

Spelling Homework Activities #1

Below is a list of spelling activities you can do with your spelling words. Choose four (4) different activities to complete each week. All spelling homework must be done in your spelling notebook. Spelling assessments will be given every Friday, so remember to study!

| Activity | How do I do it? |

| ABC ORDER If the word begins with the same letter, you look at the next letter. If the next letter is the same letter, move on to the letter after that. Example: <u>S</u> <u>T</u> <u>A</u> <u>R</u> <u>M</u> <u>S</u> <u>T</u> <u>A</u> <u>R</u> <u>E</u> | Write your words in alphabetical order, making sure to look at ALL the letters; not just the first one. |
| Sentences | Choose 6 of your words and write each word in a sentence. Remember capitals and punctuation. |
| Rhyming Words | Write your spelling words and next to them write at least one rhyming word. Underline your spelling words. Example: <u>kite</u> - bite, might |
| Vowels and Consonants | Write your spelling words using a blue colored pencil for consonants and a red colored pencil for vowels. |
| Ransom Words | Write 6 of your spelling words by cutting out letters from a newspaper or magazine and gluing them into your spelling notebook. |
| Stair Steps | Write your spelling words as "stair steps". Example: d do dog |

Words in a Word

Choose 6 of your spelling words and write them in your notebook and underline them. Then write at least three words that you can make from each. You may scramble the letters to create new words.

Example: shower - show, how, owe, row, he

Telephone Words

Write your spelling words. Then turn your words into numbers by using the telephone keypad. Find the value of each letter and then add them up.

Example: block - $b(2) + l(5) + o(6) + c(2) + k(5) = 20$
